St Patrick's Day Festival Boulder Racecourse, 18 March 1909

As part of a day-long festival, held the day after St Patrick's Day at the Boulder Racecourse, which included athletic events, greyhound racing and foot racing, there was also a 10-mile handicap race for motor cars - the first recorded motor car race in Western Australia.
